

**CHICAGO****Medal of Honor winners  
to meet in city in 2009**

An annual convention that recognizes recipients of the Medal of Honor will be held in Chicago in 2009, Mayor Richard Daley announced Thursday.

About 60 recipients are expected to attend the Chicago convention, to be held Sept. 15-19, during which they will be honored and visit local schools to talk about sacrifices made by the nation's military.

The medal, typically presented by the president on behalf of Congress, is the country's highest award for military valor.

The convention is held annually and this year's gathering is to be held Sept. 3-10 in Green Bay.
